TO WEYMOUTH 219 MILES. WITH A COEFFICIENT OF 2.466.

IN 1997 THE JUDGE GB 95 N 16415 HAD A COEFFICIENT OVER SIX  
RACES OF  
1.56.

BOTH BIRDS WERE DISQUALIFIED FROM ENTERING THE  
COMPETITION BECAUSE THEY HAD FLOWN TOO FAR.  
(OVER 185 MILES)

THIS YEAR (1997) WINNING COEFFICIENTS  
IN THE VERSELE-LAGA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS SPRINT SECTION  
WERE.

FIRST.....	1.039
SECOND.....	2.116
THIRD.....	3.064
FOURTH.....	3.180

HAD THEY NOT BEEN DISQUALIFIED (HAVING FLOWN TOO FAR)  
THE JUDGE WOULD HAVE BEEN SECOND 1.56 AND THE CHIEF  
CONSTABLE WOULD HAVE AGAIN BEEN FOURTH 2.466.

In the first two OPEN races of 1997 the Judge came together with his sire  
Fulwood Cracker to take 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> had there not been the stupid rule only one  
rubber in a thimble they would have been clocked together to take joint 1<sup>st</sup>.  
This would have given the Judge a coefficient of 0.981. which would have  
beat the World Championship Pigeon.
